Sights of Picton 1 Hour

No visit to Picton is complete unless you have seen it from a lookout and we have a few to share.

Picton is a beautiful harbour town and it is the gateway to the South Island, the Interisland Ferries arrive and depart from here. Over one million visitors a year pass through this tiny town and in the summer season the population of around 4,000 trebles.

It boasts stunning vistas of the Marlborough Sounds and hosts around 40 cruise ships per season. Just a stone's throw from the famous Marlborough vineyards and wineries there is so much to see and do here. Sheltered bays and coves, luxury accommodation, swim with dolphins or take a cruise, excellent dining and of course don't forget our world famous Queen Charlotte Track. We would love to have you stay a while but if you don't have time make sure you have a good look at this delightful part of New Zealand's South Island.

The Sights of Picton, one hour tour starts at the Victoria Park Lookout, overlooking the harbour with stunning views back to Picton town and out Queen Charlotte Sound. There are two lookouts stops here.

You will then be driven past Waikawa township and Marina to Karaka Point, a significant Maori Historical site and more beautiful views around Port Underwood Rd. On returning to Picton you will take in a view of the town from the Western side of the harbour directly above the Interislander wharf .
